SIMPLE PRESENT STATEMENTS

Affirmative

I	eat	breakfast at 7:00 in the morning
You	start	school at 7:30 on Mondays.
He	works	downtown.
She	walks	to school everyday.
We	run	in the park on Sundays.
They	play	videogames after school.

Negative

I	don't eat	breakfast at school
You	don't start	school in the afternoon.
He	doesn't work	on Sundays.
She	doesn't walk	home, she takes a taxi.
We	don't run	in the park on Mondays.
They	don't play	videogames in the morning.

don't = do not
doesn't = does not

Affirmative

Negative

I	eat	I	don't eat
You	eat	You	don't eat
He	eats	He	doesn't eat
She	eats	She	doesn't eat
We	eat	We	don't eat
They	eat	They	don't eat
It	eats	It	doesn't eat

He / She / It

My mom	has	a car.
My father	does	a lot of work at home.
The bus	goes	downtown.
