Grammar Reminder



Affirmative (+)

Subject + have/has + V.3

e.g. She **has finished** her homework.



Negative (-)

Subject + have/has not + V.3

e.g. She **hasn't finished** her homework.



Question (?)

Have/Has + Subject + V.3 ...?

e.g. **Has she finished** her homework?
