Pronunciation Worksheet | A1-A2

Learn how silent E changes a short vowel sound into a long vowel sound.

RULE

Magic E comes at the end of a word.

The E is silent - we do not pronounce it.

But it changes the vowel sound: the short vowel becomes long.

Compare: plan -> plane cap -> cape kit -> kite hop -> hope not -> note cub -> cube
