Aktivitas 1. Mengenal Report Text

Report text is a text that (1) about things in general, such as animals, plants, places, or natural phenomena. It is written based on (2) and factual information after observation and systematic analysis. Unlike descriptive text, which describes (3) thing or object, report text describes things in general as a whole class or group. Report text is commonly found in (4) , scientific journals, and textbooks.

Aktivitas 2. Struktur Report Text

Report text memiliki dua bagian struktur generik, yaitu general classification (pernyataan umum tentang objek yang akan dibahas) dan description (penjelasan rinci mengenai ciri, kebiasaan, atau bagian-bagian objek tersebut). Bacalah teks berikut, kemudian kerjakan aktivitas di bawahnya!

Komodo Dragon

Paragraf 1: The Komodo dragon (*Varanus komodoensis*) is the largest living species of lizard in the world. It can be found on several Indonesian islands, including Komodo, Rinca, Flores, and Gili Motang.

Paragraf 2: Komodo dragons can grow up to three metres in length and weigh up to seventy kilograms. They have thick, scaly skin, sharp claws, and a long, forked tongue that they use to smell their surroundings. Komodo dragons are carnivorous animals. They eat deer, wild boar, water buffalo, and sometimes smaller Komodo dragons. They hunt using their sharp sense of smell and a powerful bite that contains venomous saliva to weaken their prey.

Paragraf 3: Komodo dragons usually live alone and are most active during the day. They are excellent swimmers and can also climb trees when they are young. Because of their limited habitat, Komodo dragons are now classified as an endangered species and are protected by Indonesian law.

Aktivitas 3. Ciri Kebahasaan Report Text
