Read the following extract about background and themes of the book.

After analyzing the English history, Robin of Locksley appears in poetry *before* the known book, in English songs of the 14th century. Many of the people in the songs are real – King Richard, who ruled England between 1189 and 1199, and his brother, John, who became King at the age of his brother death. Many of the places are real, too – Sherwood Forest for example, and the nearby city of Nottingham with its famous castle that has been there *since* 1068.

There have been people living in the forests throughout the Middle Ages, who killed and ate the King's deer, which were against the law. *Until* nowadays, it is uncertain whether there was one particular outlaw called Robin Hood. The theme of the Robin Hood stories exists *since* the ancient times.

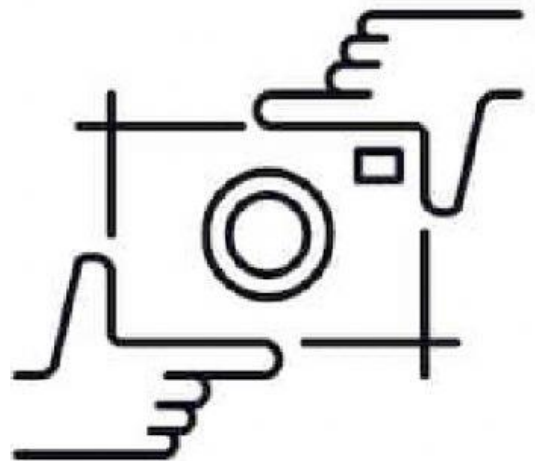
