12. The middle joint of your arm that allows you to bend your arm when lifting weights. _____
13. The muscular organ inside your mouth used for swallowing, tasting, and articulating speech. _____

15. The organ of hearing located on the side of your head. _____
16. The organ of sight that allows you to process light, colors, and visual information. _____
