Preserving traditional craft villages plays a vital role in maintaining Viet Nam's cultural identity. Across the country, hundreds of craft villages, such as Bat Trang pottery village, Van Phuc silk village, and Doi Tam drum-making village, have flourished for centuries. In these local communities, unique craftsmanship techniques have been passed down from generation to generation by dedicated artisans.

For local residents, handicraft production is not merely a means of earning a living; it also fosters a strong sense of community. Neighbours often collaborate in purchasing raw materials, sharing equipment, and promoting their products to tourists. Furthermore, many craft villages have turned into popular tourist attractions. Visitors flock to these places to observe craftsmen at work, buy authentic souvenirs, and even try making handicrafts themselves.

However, many traditional craft villages are currently facing serious challenges. Young people in rural areas often move to big cities in search of modern, higher-paying jobs, leaving fewer successors to learn the trade. Additionally, competition from mass-produced factory goods has rendered some traditional items less competitive in price. friendly technology, and digital promotion. By combining ancient craftsmanship with modern tourism, these villages can continue to thrive.
