

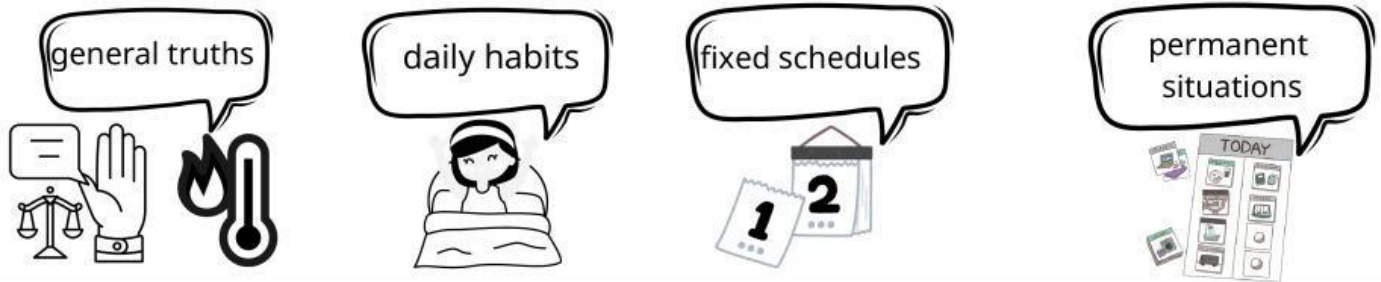

PRESENT SIMPLE TENSE



Type	To be	Verbs
Affirmative (+)	S + am / is / are + ...	S + V(s/es) + ...
Negative (-)	S + am / is / are + not + ...	S + do / does + not + V(inf) + ...
Interrogative (?)	Am / Is / Are + S + ...?	Do / Does + S + V(inf) + ...?
 Note	I -> am He / She / It / Singular Noun -> is You / We / They / Plural Noun -> are	I / You / We / They / Plural Noun -> V(inf) => (Do) He / She / It / Singular Noun -> V(s/es) => (Does)

COMMON MISTAKES



✗ She go to school every day.
✓ She goes to school every day.



✗ Does he likes English?
✓ Does he like English?



✗ They doesn't study on Sundays.
✓ They don't study on Sundays.

SPELLING RULES FOR THIRD-PERSON SINGULAR (He / She / It / Singular Noun)

- ADD -ES For verbs ending in: -ch, -sh, -s, -x, -z, -o (watch -> watches, wash -> washes)
- CHANGE -Y TO -IES For verbs ending in:

Consonant + Y

study --> studies

fly --> flies

Note: Vowel + Y -> just add -S

play -> plays

enjoy -> enjoys

- ADD -S For most other verbs (work -> works , speak -> speaks)
