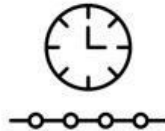
I. WHAT IS THE PRESENT SIMPLE?

We use the Present Simple to talk about:

Daily routines

General facts

Timetables and schedules



II. FORM

1. Affirmative

Subject	Verb
I/ You/ We/ They	Base verb
He/ She/ It	Verb + s/es

I go to school every day.

She works in an office.



2. Negative

Subject	Verb
I/ You/ We/ They + do not	Base verb
He/ She/ It + does not	Base verb

I **do not** like coffee.

He **does not** watch TV at night.



3. Yes/ No Questions

Do + I/ You/ We/ They + base verb?

Does + He/ She/ It + base verb?

Examples:

Do you play football?

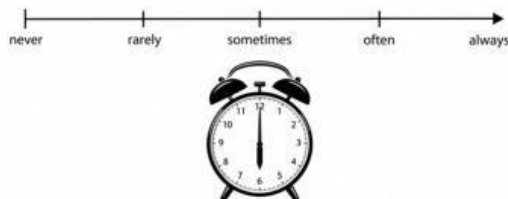
Does she live near here?



III. ADVERBS OF FREQUENCY

Adverb	Vietnamese meaning	Frequency percentage
always	luôn luôn	100%
usually	thường thường	80%
sometimes	thỉnh thoảng	50%
never	Không bao giờ	0%

Examples: I usually get up at 6 a.m.

She **go** to school every day -> She **goes** to school every day

Does he **likes** music? -> Does **he** like music?
