II. Form

1. Affirmative

Subject	Verb
I / You / We / They	work / study / play
He / She / It	works / studies / plays

Examples

	
I go to school everyday	She works in the office

2. Negative

Subject + do/does not + base verb

Examples

	
I do not like coffee.	He does not watch TV at night.

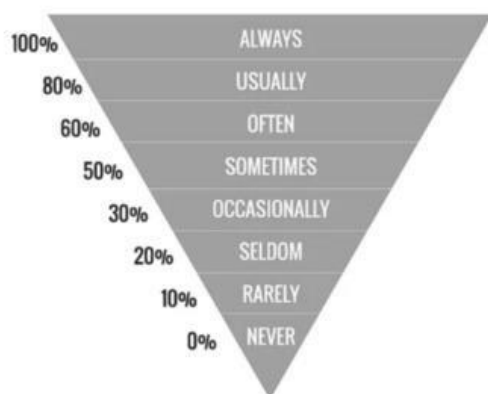
3. Yes/No Questions

Do/Does + subject + base verb?

Examples:

- Do you play football?
- Does she live near here?
