1. WHAT IS THE PRESENT SIMPLE?

We use the Present Simple to talk about:



Daily routines
I get up at 6:00 AM every morning.



General facts
Water boils at 100°C.



Timetables and schedules
The train leaves at 8:00 AM.

1.1 AFFIRMATIVE

Subject	Verb	Example
I / You / We / They	work / study / play	I go to school everyday.
He / She / It	works / studies / plays	She works in an office.

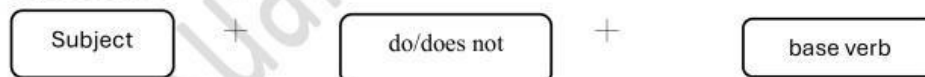
I (Subject) + go (verb) + to school every day.



She (Subject) + works (verb + s/es) + in an office.



1.2 NEGATIVE



I do not (don't) like coffee



He does not (doesn't) watch TV



Note: We add "s" or "es" to the verb when the subject is He, She, or It

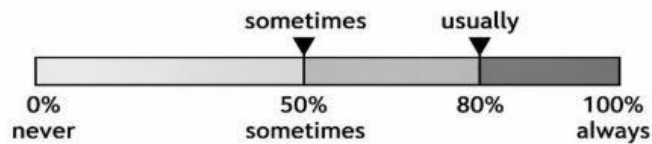
