AFFIRMATIVE	V	V-s/ es	She gets up at 6 a.m. every day.
NEGATIVE	do not/ don't + V	does not/ doesn't + V	I don't get up early on Sundays.
QUESTION	Do + S + V?	Does + S + V?	Do you get up early on weekdays?

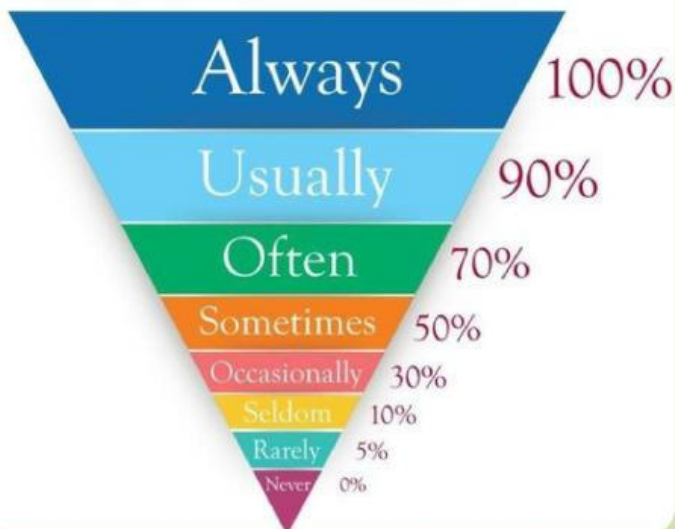

ADVERBS OF FREQUENCY



We use **adverbs of frequency** to show **how often an action happens**.

Adverbs of Frequency



EXAMPLES:

- I *usually* **get** up at 7 a.m.
- She **is** *always* on time.
- He **doesn't** *usually* **go** to bed late.
