II. AFFIRMATIVE FORM:

SUBJECT	VERB	EXAMPLE
I / You / We / They	Base verb	I study. You play soccer. We go to school. They like coffee.
He / She / It	Base verb + s/es/ies	He works. She studies. It flies.

III. NEGATIVE FORM:

SUBJECT	VERB	EXAMPLE
I / You / We / They	don't + base verb	I don't like coffee.
He / She / It	doesn't + base verb	She doesn't like coffee.

IV. YES / NO QUESTIONS:

Do / Does	Subject	Base verb.....?	Example
Do	I / You / We / They	Base verb	Do you like English?
Does	He / She / It	Base verb	

Short answers:

Yes, I/ you/ we/ they do.

Yes, he/she/it does.

No, I/you/we/they don't.

No, he/she/it doesn't.
