1. Most nouns add **-s**



cat



cats



book

chairs

2. Nouns ending in **-s, -sh, -ch, -x or -z** add **-es**



bus



buses



dish



dishes



watch



watches



fox



foxes



box



boxes



quiz



quizzes

3. Nouns ending in a **consonant + y** change the y to i and add **-es**



baby



babies



cherry



cherries



factory



factories



story



stories

y → i + es

4. Nouns ending in a **vowel + y** just add **-s**



boy



boys



toy



toys



key



keys



monkey



monkeys

5. Irregular plural forms



child → children



mouse → mice



foot → feet



tooth → teeth



person → people



ox



oxen

Remember!

- ✓ A plural noun means more than one.
- ✓ We usually add -s or -es.
- ✓ Some nouns change form (irregular).
- ✓ The meaning of the noun stays the same.
