RELATIVE CLAUSES WITH WHO AND THAT

We use **relative clauses** to give more information about a person or thing.

WHO: Use **who** for people.

- Tom Holland is an actor **who** plays Spider-Man.
- She is a singer **who** has many fans.
- I like actors **who** are funny.

THAT: Use **that** for people or things in defining relative clauses.

- Tom is an actor **that** works in many movies.
- This is the movie **that** I watched yesterday.
- She is an actress **that** many people know.

We use **-ing adjectives** to describe the **person, thing, movie, activity, etc. that causes a feeling**.

- The movie is **exciting**.
- The story is **interesting**.
- The film is **frightening**.

We use **-ed adjectives** to describe **how a person feels**.

- I am **excited** about the movie.
- She is **interested** in the story.
- They are **frightened** by the film.
