Formal Self-Introductions

Master the art of professional introductions for business meetings, formal events, or when meeting someone important.

Set the Tone: Professional Greetings

- Good Morning (for a vibrant start)
- Good afternoon (for mid-day encounters)
- Good evening (for dignified late-day introductions)

Confidently Introduce Yourself

- Allow me to introduce myself
- I'd like to introduce myself
- My name is [full name]

To conclude with poise and respect, remember that "It is a pleasure to meet you" and "It is a pleasure to meet you too" are the quintessential formal responses that demonstrate impeccable professionalism.

Elevate your inquiry: In formal situations, always choose the distinguished "What is your name?" over the more casual "What's your name?".

Introducing a Third Person – Informal

When you need to introduce friends, family members, or casual acquaintances to each other.

Person 1 Introduces

- This is Mauro (Person 3)
- This is my girlfriend Mary (person)

Person 2 Responds

- Hi Mauro, I'm Person 2, nice to meet you
- Hello Mary, My name's Person 2. Nice to meet you

Person 3 Responds

- Hi person 2, nice to meet you too
- Hello Person 2. Nice to meet you too

Introducing a Third Person – Formal

Professional introductions require more structured language and show respect for titles and positions.

Business Introduction

Person 1: "I want you to meet Mr. Zapata. He is my boss"

Person 2: "Hello, Mr. Zapata, My name is Person 2. It's nice to meet you"

Person 3: "Hello person 2. It's nice to meet you too"

Academic Introduction

Person 1: "I'd like you to meet Mr. Hernandez. He is my English teacher"

Person 2: "Hello Mr. Hernandez. My name is Person 2. It is a pleasure to meet you"

Person 3: "Hello Person 2. It is a pleasure to meet you too"



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Introducing someone

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Greetings and How Are You

Essential greeting exchanges for different levels of formality and various ways to ask about someone's well-being.

Questions (Person 1)	Answers (Person 2)	Answers (Person 1)
Are you ok?	Yes, I am. Thanks! And you?	I'm fine / I'm very well / I'm very good / I'm ok
How are you?	Fine, thanks and you? / Very well, thanks and you? / I'm very good, thanks and you?	I'm fine / I'm very well / I'm very good / I'm ok
How are you doing?	Fine, thanks and you? / Very well, thanks and you? / I'm very good, thanks and you? / I'm doing well, thanks what about you? / I'm doing great, thanks and you?	I'm fine / I'm very well / I'm very good / I'm ok

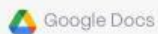

El Proceso de la Despedida (The Farewell Process)

Understanding the three-step process for saying goodbye properly in any situation.

La Señal de Cierre (The Closing Signal) Es una frase que indica que la conversación está a punto de terminar. Muestra que tienes que irte. Ejemplos: "Well, it's getting late." / "Anyway, I should get going." / "It was nice talking to you."	La Despedida Principal (The Main Farewell) Esta es la palabra o frase principal para decir adiós. Ejemplos: "Goodbye." / "See you later." / "Bye."	El Buen Deseo (The Good Wish) Es una frase amable que se añade al final para desearle algo bueno a la otra persona. Ejemplos: "Have a good day." / "Take care." / "Have a great weekend."

Farewell Examples in Context

1. **Señal de Cierre:** "Alright, I have to go now."
2. **Despedida Principal:** "See ya!"
3. **Buen Deseo:** "Have a good one!"

Formal Situation

1. **Señal de Cierre:** "It was a pleasure meeting you."
2. **Despedida Principal:** "Goodbye."
3. **Buen Deseo:** "Have a wonderful afternoon."

- It was a pleasure meeting you.
- It was nice to see you again.
- Have a wonderful day/evening.
- Farewell. (Muy formal, poco común en el día a día)

Despedidas con Planes Futuros

Cuando sabes cuándo verás a la persona

- See you tomorrow.
- See you on Monday.
- See you in class.
- Talk to you tomorrow.
