I. GRAMMAR REVISION A

1. Comparative & Superlative Adjectives



COMPARATIVES & SUPERLATIVES



1. Comparative (so sánh hơn)

Use: compare 2 people or things.

S1 + be + adj-er + than + S2
S1 + be + more + adj + than + S2

2. Superlative (so sánh nhất)

Use: compare 1 person or thing with a group.

S + be + the + adj-est
S + be + the most + adj

3. Spelling rules

Add -er / -est	tall → taller → the tallest
Adjectives ending in -e: add -r / -st	large → larger → the largest
Consonant + y → i + -er / -est	happy → happier → the happiest
One-syllable (CVC): double final consonant	big → bigger → the biggest

4. Irregular adjectives

Adjective	Comparative	Superlative
good	better	the best
bad	worse	the worst
many / much	more	the most
little	less	the least
far	farther / further	the farthest / the furthest

2. Tag questions

USE:

Use short questions at the end of a sentence to check or confirm information.



REMEMBER:

Use a subject pronoun in the tag.

Tom → he
Mai → she
the children → they

Special: I am → aren't I?



FORM:

1 Question tags with BE

(+) S + am / is / are + ..., am not / isn't / aren't + pronoun?

(-) S + am not / isn't / aren't + ..., am / is / are + pronoun?

Special: I am ..., aren't I?

2 Question tags with VERBS

(+) S + V / V(s/es) + ..., don't / doesn't + pronoun?

(-) S + don't / doesn't + V + ..., do / does + pronoun?

PRESENT SIMPLE

**USE:**

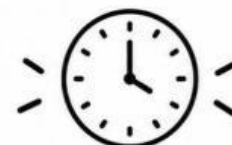
- Talk about habits and routines.
- Talk about facts and truths.
- Talk about people, things, places and feelings.

FORM:

Affirmative	S + am / is / are + ... S + V / V-e/es + ...
Negative	S + am / is / are + not + ... S + don't / doesn't + V + ...
Question	Am / Is / Are + S + ...? Do / Does + S + V + ...?

TIME WORDS:

always, usually, often, sometimes,
every day, every week, in the morning, on weekends



2. Present continuous



PRESENT CONTINUOUS

**1. USE**

- To talk about actions **happening now**.
- To talk about actions **in the present period**.

**2. FORM**

Affirmative	S + am / is / are + V-ing
Negative	S + am / is / are + not + V-ing
Question	Am / Is / Are + S + V-ing?

3. TIME WORDS

- now
- at the moment
- today
- this week
- this month
- this term

**4. EXAMPLES**

- I **am studying** now.
- She **is playing** football.
- They **are not watching** TV.
- **Are you reading** a book?



V-ing = verb + **ing** (play → playing, write → writing, run → running)
