A. THEORY

I. GRAMMAR REVISION A

1. Past Simple – Verb (Positive)

USE:

Use it for finished actions in the past.



FORM:

S + V2/ed + ...

TIME WORDS:

yesterday, last night,
last week, ago



EXAMPLES:

- I watched TV yesterday.
- She visited her grandma last weekend.
- They went to the park after school.



Regular verbs: play → played, watch → watched

Irregular verbs: go → went, have → had

2. Indefinite Pronouns

everybody, nobody, someone, anyone, something, anything

Word	Use	Example
everybody	all people	Everybody likes music.
nobody	no people	Nobody is in the classroom.
someone	one person	Someone is at the door.
anyone	any person (questions / negatives)	Is anyone at home?
something	one thing	I have something for you.
anything	any thing (questions / negatives)	I don't want anything.

NOTES:

- Everybody / Nobody + singular verb
- Someone / something are common in positive sentences. Anyone / anything are common in questions and negatives.

Countable Nouns	Uncountable Nouns
• can be counted • one apple / two apples • use a / an • use many, a few • ask: How many...? • examples: book, egg, chair	• cannot usually be counted • water, rice, milk • no a / an • use much, a little, some • ask: How much...?
 book  egg  chair	 water  rice  milk
Use containers: a bottle of water, a bowl of rice	
 There are many books on the table.	There is some milk in the fridge. 

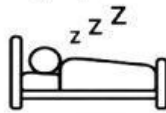
4. Quantifiers

Word	Use	Example
both	two people / things together	Both boys are happy.
all	every person / thing in a group	All the students are here.
fewer	with countable nouns	We have fewer apples today.
less	with uncountable nouns	She drinks less milk now.
not as many	compare countable nouns	I don't have as many books as Lan.
not as much	compare uncountable nouns	We don't have as much time as yesterday.

Countable: books, apples, students

Uncountable: milk, water, time

5. Modal Verbs: must, should, shouldn't

must = strong rule / necessity You must wear a helmet. 	should = advice / a good idea You should do your homework. 	shouldn't = advice not to do something You shouldn't stay up late. 
FORM: S + must / should / shouldn't + V1	NOTE: No 'to' after a modal verb.	
Must is stronger than should.
