

Activity 3 –Diana’s Death

On the evening of August 31, 1997, Diana was dining privately in the Ritz Hotel in Paris. (1) ----- 11:30 that night, as she left the hotel she (2) ----- by paparazzi, despite the fact that significant security precautions had been taken, including the use of a decoy vehicle, which left from the front of the hotel.

The death of Princess Diana was immediately (3)----- by an unprecedented outpouring of grief from all over the world.

Initially, the accident had been blamed on her French driver who may have been exceeding the speed limit to avoid the paparazzi. The inquest jury ruled that both Paul and the paparazzi chasing Diana were responsible for the crash (4)----- “gross negligence.”
