SAND AND STONE

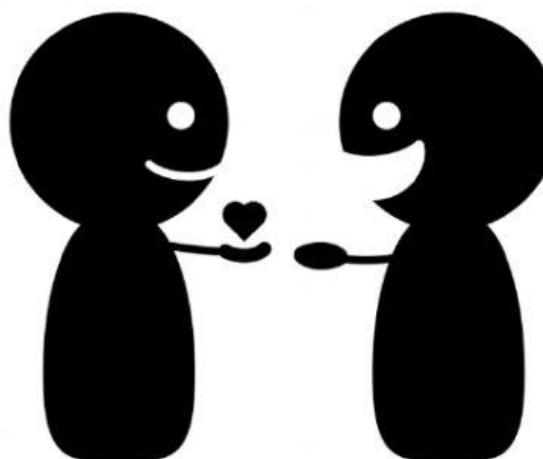
A story tells that two friends were walking through the desert.
