	Mostly transmitted through poor hygiene. It is usually found in human feces and transmitted from hand to mouth.
	Transmitted when female worm deposits eggs in and around the anus. Most common of all parasitic roundworm infections.
	Contracted by coming in contact with it on your hands. Third most common roundworm to infect humans.
	Acquired through direct contact with contaminated soil. Enters through the skin and then makes its way to the intestines.
