Look at the following table about **OBJECT PRONOUNS**.

SUBJECT PRONOUNS	OBJECT PRONOUNS
I	me
you	you
he	him
she	her
it	it
we	us
they	them



Object Pronouns substitute a noun / expression that is the Object of a sentence.

▶ These Pronouns are placed after **the verb**:
Mary **loves** Peter. = Mary **loves** him.

▶ Object Pronouns can follow **a preposition**:
She thinks **about** Peter.
= She thinks **about** him.




