Written by Freddie Mercury, it is one of Queen's most popular songs, and one of rock's most recognizable anthems.

The lead guitarist Brian May said, "We wanted to get the crowds waving and singing. It's very unifying and positive."

"We Are the Champions" has become an anthem for victories at sporting events.

In July 2016 the song was used to introduce Donald Trump to the Republican National Convention in Cleveland. Queen immediately issued a statement denouncing Trump's use of the song as not authorized by the band.
