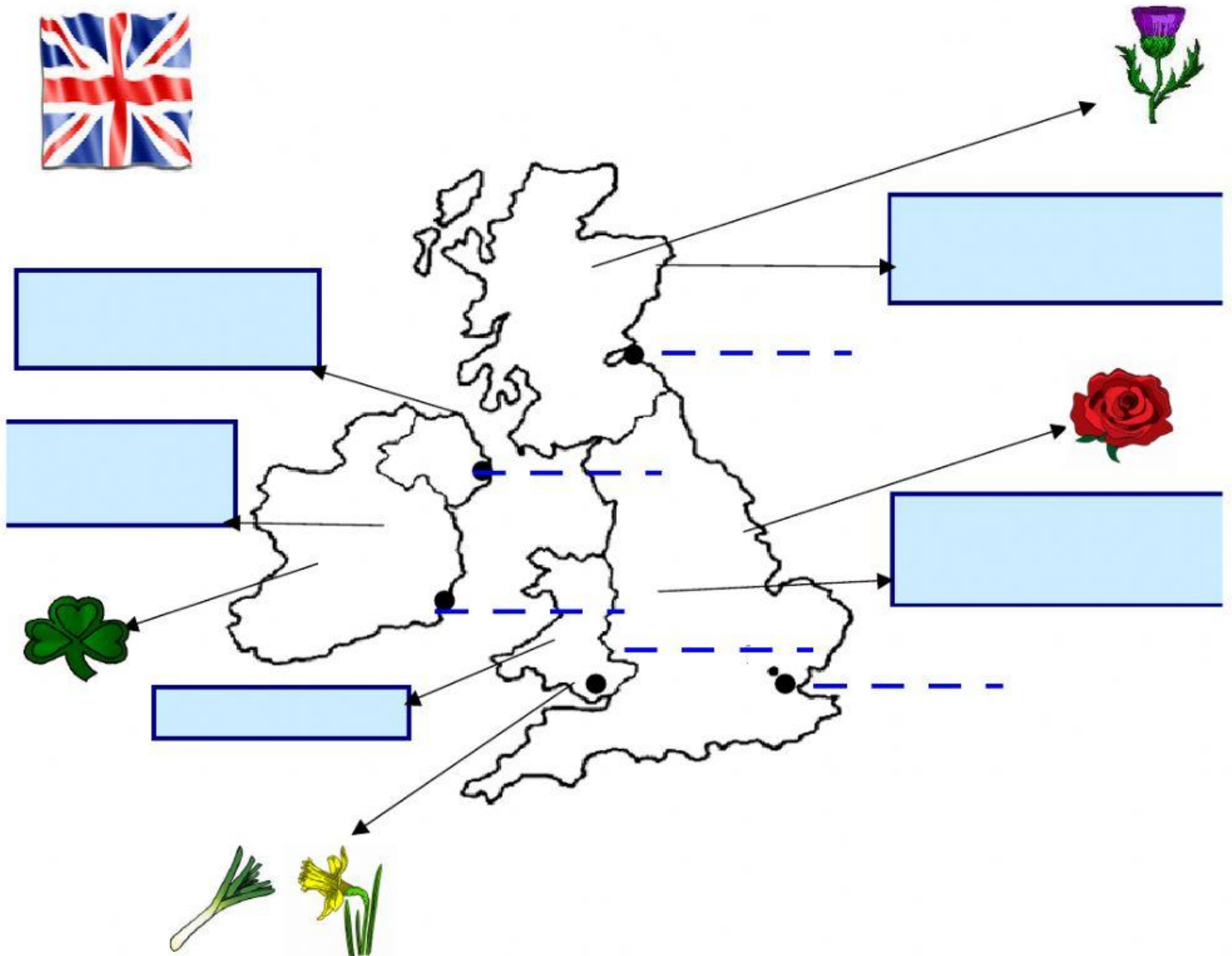


# THE BRITISH ISLES
