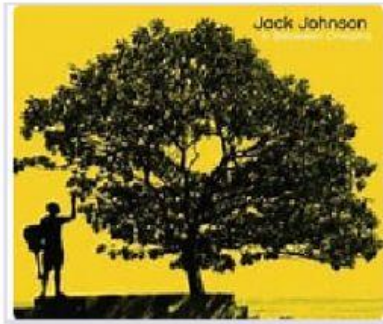


Modals in "Better Together" by Jack Johnson
