


## Re-connect

### NYC Quick Facts


- New York City is located in the **north** of the USA, on the **east** coast. It is situated in the state of New York.
- There are 8.5 million **inhabitants** in NYC. 



- New York City is divided into five **boroughs**:
  - Manhattan
  - Brooklyn
  - the Bronx
  - Queens
  - Staten Island.

- 200 languages 
- 237 skyscrapers 
- 5,000 street food vendors 
- 468 subway stations 
- 13,000 cabs 
- currency = dollar 

- Manhattan forms a grid of 228 **streets** and 12 **avenues**. 2 avenues and 2 streets form a rectangle called a **block**.


