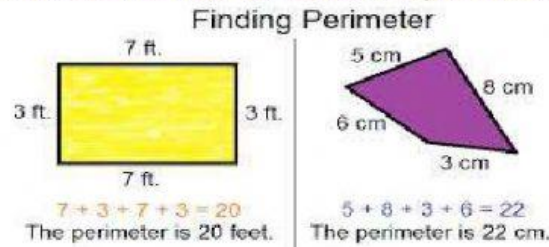

Review Perimeter, Area, and Volume

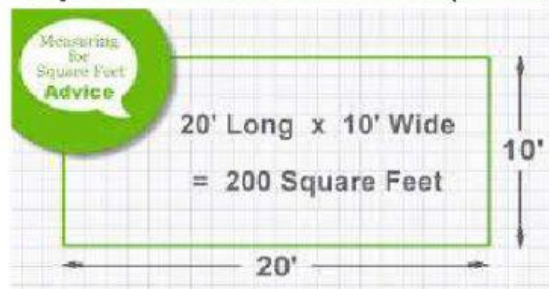
PERIMETER is the measure of distance **AROUND** a figure.

- a) to find perimeter, **ADD up ALL the sides**
- b) put the **unit of measure** with the answer (16 in., 28 ft., etc.)



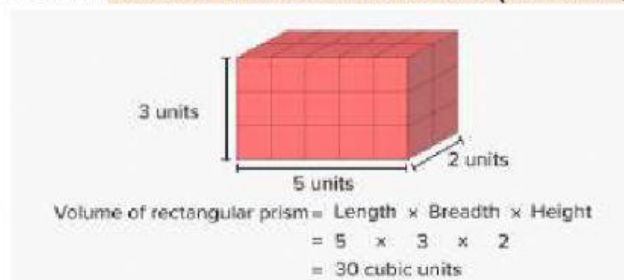
AREA is the amount of distance all **ACROSS** a figure.

- a) to find area, **MULTIPLY length x width ($A = lw$)**
- b) put the answer in **squared units** of measure (12 ft.², 9 in.², etc.)



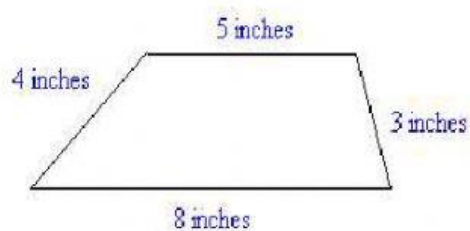
VOLUME is the amount of space **INSIDE** a 3-D figure.

- a) to find volume, **MULTIPLY length x width x height ($V = lwh$)**
- b) put the answer in **cubed units** of measure (42 cm.³, 8 yd.³, etc.)

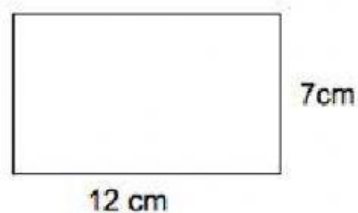
