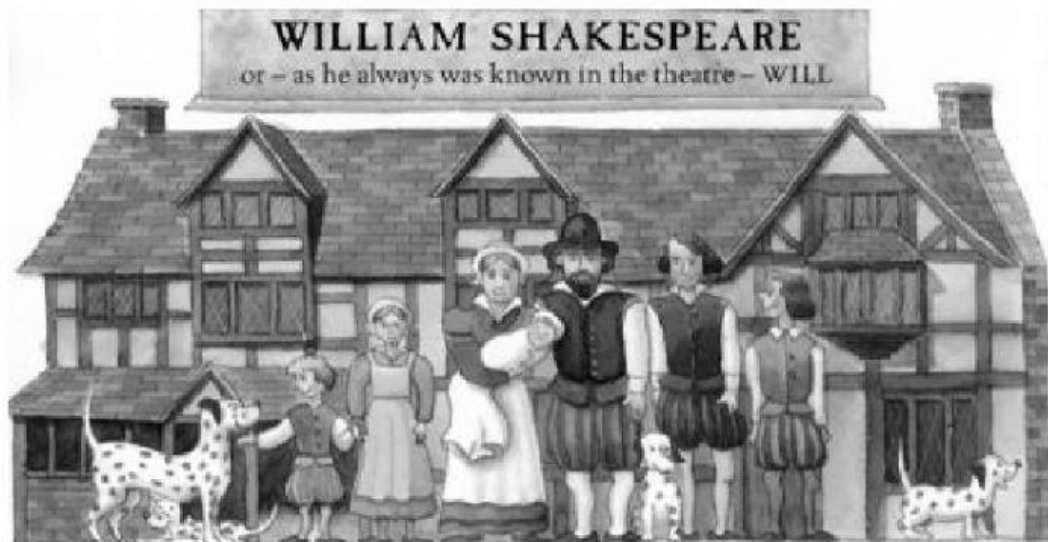


Read the text about William Shakespeare. Are the sentences 1-7 true, false or not given?
