BRIEF INTRODUCTION

The word **photography** comes from the Greek words mean **“drawing with light.”** It is said that photography is method of picture making that started in early 19th century. It is based on principles of light, optics, and chemistry.

The first permanent photograph was captured in 1826 (some sources say 1827) by **Joseph Nicéphore Niépce** in France. It shows the roof of a building lit by the sun.

PRACTICAL TIPS IN TAKING PICTURES

1. Try to find a camera that you can used and practiced with.
2. Get to know your camera.
3. Look for opportunities for taking photographs-in mall, in an arcade, in a car, or in your room.
4. Use your camera at different times of the day.

5. Do not make photography a hindrance to what you are doing.
6. Observe your subject or topic as close as possible.
7. Do not worry about rules for now. Experimenting is essential in photography when you are starting.
8. Focus, lighting, and distance affect the quality of photos taken.
9. Try to get as close as you can to your subject.

Sometimes, one image does not tell the entire story. Instead, set of images is needed to complete the tale or message. This is what is known as a photographic or **photo essay**.
