

Writing Thesis Statements

A **thesis statement** is one sentence that establishes the focus of your essay. It should have a TOPIC, CLAIM, and at least 2 SUBTOPICS.

Example Activity

Topic: You have won the lottery and can choose to travel anywhere in the world. Write about one place you would like to visit and explain why you would like to travel there.

Supports:

1. I would travel to France because I love **French food**.
2. **Paris** is one of the most beautiful cities in the world and I would like to see it.

Thesis Statement: If I won the lottery and could travel anywhere in the world, I would travel to France because I love **French food** and want to see **Paris**.
