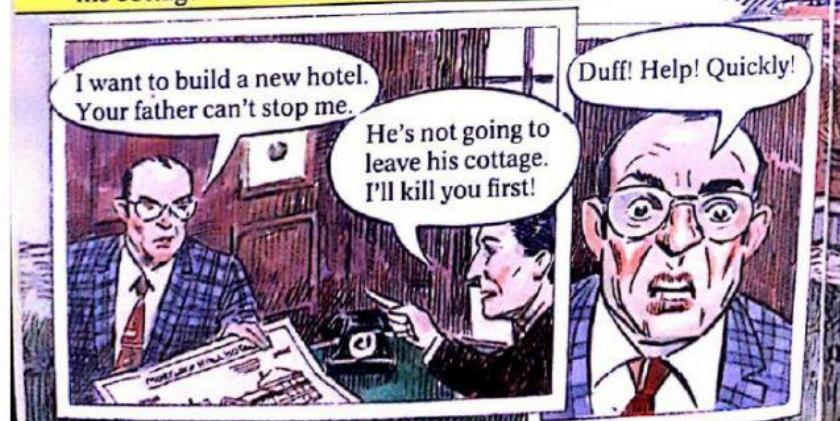
'But what about my father's cottage?' shouted French.
