1. If $3 \times 5 = 15$, then $15 \div 5 = \underline{\hspace{2cm}}$
2. If $4 \times 10 = 40$, then $40 \div 10 = \underline{\hspace{2cm}}$
3. If $6 \times 5 = 30$, then $30 \div 5 = \underline{\hspace{2cm}}$
4. If $0 \times 5 = 0$, then $0 \div 5 = \underline{\hspace{2cm}}$
5. If $8 \times 2 = 16$, then $16 \div 2 = \underline{\hspace{2cm}}$
6. If $2 \times 2 = 4$, then $4 \div 2 = \underline{\hspace{2cm}}$
7. If $7 \times 5 = 35$, then $35 \div 5 = \underline{\hspace{2cm}}$
