

Mathematics - Using Exponents

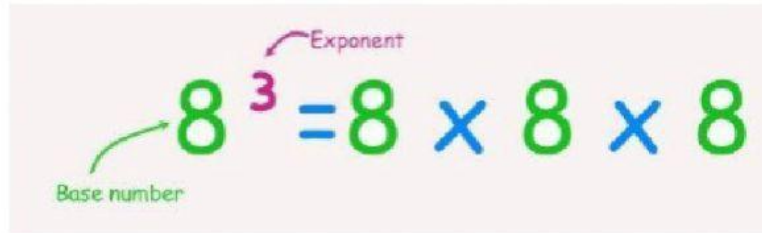
