Urban Community (Cities)



- many people living close together
- small amount of space
- not very much open space or natural areas



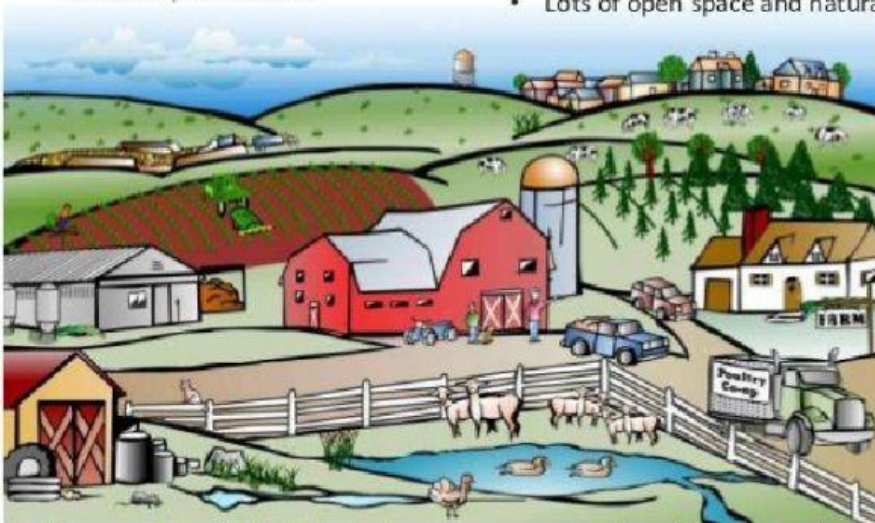
Tall Buildings
Skyscrapers



- Fewer people
- A few buildings spread out over large distances
- Lots of open space and natural areas

Rural Community

"the country" or farmland



- Must drive because it is too far to walk
- Roads are not paved, so people need special vehicles, like pick-up trucks
- Farms have special types of vehicles (tractors)

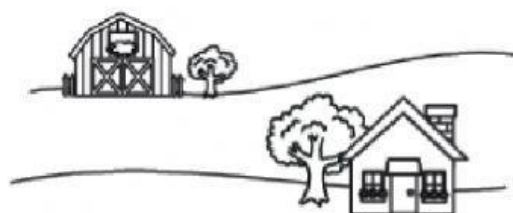

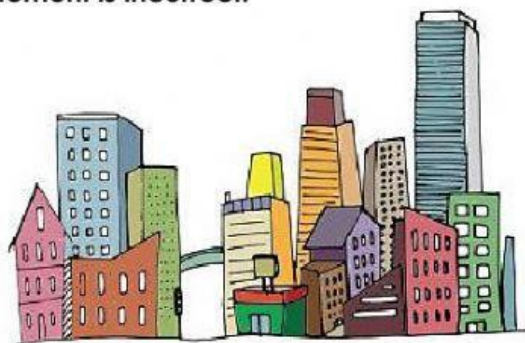
