To talk about future, you can use the following tenses

WILL	GOING TO	PRESENT CONTINUOUS	PRESENT SIMPLE
PREDICTIONS AND FORECASTS - I think Real Madrid will win. - It will be rainy all week.	INTENTIONS - I'm going to play basketball tomorrow.	ARRANGEMENTS AND PLANS - He's flying to Milan on Tuesday.	TIMETABLES - Bus timetables - Train timetables - Movie timetables - Flight timetables The movie is at 5 o'clock.
SPONTANEOUS DECISIONS - I'll help you with the bags.	PREVIOUSLY MADE DECISIONS - We're going to go camping this summer.	- We're meeting friends on Friday.	SCHEDULED / REPEATED EVENTS - I'm seeing a movie on Sunday afternoon. - It's going to rain.
OFFERS / PROMISES - I'll help you with your homework. - I'll see you tomorrow.	SOMETHING THAT IS VERY LIKELY - Look at those clouds.		- It's her birthday tomorrow. - I have an English class on Thursday.
