To talk about future, you can use the following tenses

WILL	GOING TO	PRESENT CONTINUOUS	PRESENT SIMPLE
<b>PREDICTIONS AND FORECASTS</b> - I think Real Madrid will win. - It will be rainy all week.	<b>INTENTIONS</b> - I'm going to play basketball tomorrow.	<b>ARRANGEMENTS AND PLANS</b> - He's flying to Milan on Tuesday.	<b>TIMETABLES</b> - Bus timetables - Train timetables - Movie timetables - Flight timetables The movie is at 5 o'clock.
<b>SPONTANEOUS DECISIONS</b> - I'll help you with the bags.	<b>PREVIOUSLY MADE DECISIONS</b> - We're going to go camping this summer.	- We're meeting friends on Friday.	<b>SCHEDULED / REPEATED EVENTS</b> - It's her birthday tomorrow. - I have an English class on Thursday.
<b>OFFERS / PROMISES</b> - I'll help you with your homework. - I'll see you tomorrow.	<b>SOMETHING THAT IS VERY LIKELY</b> - Look at those clouds. It's going to rain.	- I'm seeing a movie on Sunday afternoon.
