I go to bed at 10.30 p.m.

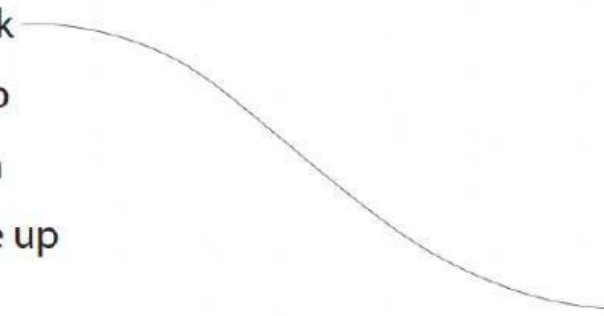
