Countable nouns

- ✓ There **are** lots of eggs.
- ✓ There **are** some eggs.
- ✓ There **are** a few eggs.
- ✗ There **aren't** any eggs.



Uncountable nouns

- ✓ There **is** lots of sugar.
- ✓ There **is** some sugar.
- ✓ There **is** a little sugar.
- ✗ There **isn't** any sugar.



Are there **any** eggs?

Yes, there **are** / No, there **aren't**.

Is there **any** sugar?

Yes, there **is** / No there **isn't**.


