What are they?			<p>It is accepted and transcends cultural norms.</p> <p>The rules of conduct recognized in respect to a particular class of human actions or a particular culture or Group</p>
Where do they come from?			<p>Are accepted and governed by professionals and legal guidelines within a particular time and place.</p> <p>Because we believe in something being right or wrong</p>
Why we do it?			<p>Individual-Internal</p> <p>Because society says it is the right thing to do.</p>
Flexibility			<p>Social system-external</p> <p>Are dependent on others. They tend to be consistent within a certain context.</p>
Acceptability			<p>Principles or habits with respect to right or wrong conduct. "Dos and don'ts". A personal compass of right and wrong.</p> <p>Usually consistent. It can change if an individual's beliefs change</p>
