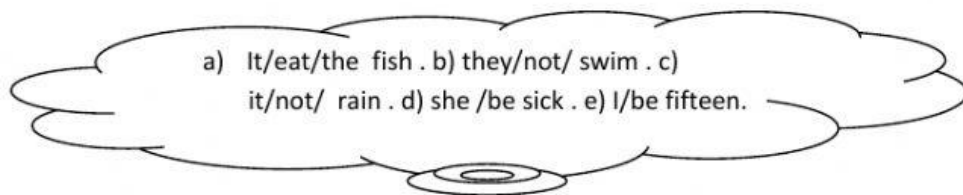


I .- Going to for PREDICTIONS

We use GOING TO when we make a prediction based on evidence .

Evidence	Prediction .
Sam's running really fast .	He's going to win the race
John never does his homework.	He isn't going to pass the final exam.
Anna is angry with Peter.	She's not going to come to his party.
