- However, the explorer Ulysses Klaw finds his way to Wakanda, hiding his work on a vibranium-based sonic powered weapon. When discovered, Klaw kills T'Chaka only to see his "Sound Blaster" turn against him in a duel with then-teen T'Challa. Klaw's right hand is destroyed, and he and his men flee.
- Realizing that others would attempt to manipulate and dominate Wakanda to obtain this rare and valuable mineral, T'Chaka could close his country's borders to the rest of the world. The valuable Vibranium is sold abroad in small quantities, surreptitiously sent to the best specialists in the country to study abroad, which has positioned Wakanda as one of the most technologically advanced nations in the world.
- In the distant past, Wakanda was hit by the drop in the price of compound for the mysterious mineral called vibranium, capable of absorbing sound and vibrations, which was discovered a generation before the events of the coup. T'Challa, the current Black Panther, is the son of King T'Chaka, Black Panther before him and descendant of King Bashenga.
- Vibranium radiation has permeated much of Wakanda's flora and fauna, including the heart-shaped grass eaten by members of the Black Panther Cult.
- Wakanda has an unusually high rate of mutation produced by the dangerous mutagenic properties of the Vibranium mound. A large number of Wakanda mutants are working for Erik Killmonger.
