

Usually or Used To

'Used to' is used to describe actions or habits which occurred in the past.

'Usually' is used to describe regular actions or habits which happen in the present.

E.g. I **used to** wear mini-skirts when I was young. (I no longer wear mini-skirts)

I **usually** drink coffee when I wake up in the morning. (Almost always)
