



**The position of tonal marks**

1. The tonal mark is placed on the vowel, e.g.  
*ba jün min lénɡ*
2. When there are two vowels, the tonal mark is placed on the earlier vowel in the sequence of: *ao ei u ü*, e.g.  
*duō lái hòu xiě*
3. When *i u* appear together, the tonal mark is placed on the last vowel, e.g.  
*zhui liú*
