

# Reported speech Remedial work 2

When the verb is in the **Present Simple** – Put the verb in the **Past Simple**

**Examples:** 1 - "I **like** to dress up and look nice."

*She said she **liked** to dress up and look smart.*

2 – "She **doesn't go** to the cinema with her sister"

*They said she **didn't go** to the cinema with her sister.*
