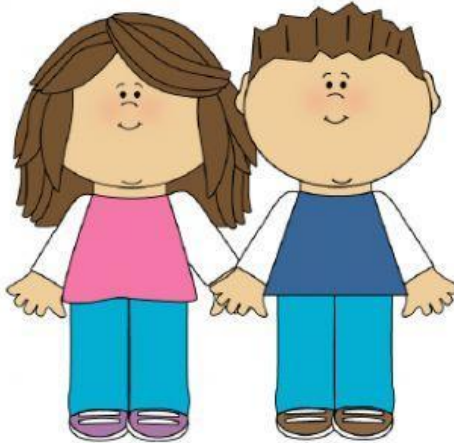


THE TWINS' DAILY ROUTINE
