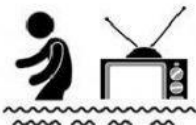

WHAT TO DO IN CASE OF TORNADO

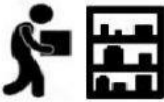
If you are outside with no shelter. Use a vehicle.

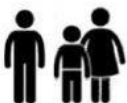
