

THE EVOLUTION OF VIDEO GAMES



1970s

In the 1970s there weren't any computers at home. People played arcade games like *Pong*. When **Atari** invented the first home console, people loved it! It was big, the graphics were basic, and the sound effects weren't realistic, but games like *Space Invaders* and *PacMan* were the most popular.

1980s

In the 1980s, games were more expensive than today. **Nintendo** invented the first mini-console called NES (*Nintendo Entertainment System*), and its *Mario* games were best-sellers. During this decade, fantasy and role-play games were so popular, but *Tetris* was the most famous puzzle game.



1990s

During the 1990s there were important technological developments, such as 3D animation and better sound effects. With consoles like **Playstation**, games were more realistic, and with **Nintendo's** portable mini consoles you could play everywhere. The most famous games were racing games like *SEGA Rally* and role-play games like *Tomb Raider*.

After 2000, video games were more sociable. They were fun for all the family: there were karaoke games, dance mats and even memory games. In 2006, **Nintendo** invented *Wii Sports* and for the first-time families came together to play video games with the Wii's remote sensor system, including games like bowling, archery, golf, tennis and more.
