Past simple regular verbs

The e in -ed is not usually pronounced, and -ed is pronounced /d/ or /t/, e.g. closed /klaʊz**d**/, stopped /stɒp**t**/. The -ed is pronounced /ɪd/ **only** in verbs which end with the sound /t/ or /d/, e.g. waited /ˈweɪt**ɪd**/ ended /ˈend**ɪd**/.
