Last night, I (not / have) dinner with my friends
..... I (have) dinner with my family?



Paola (see) a big animal in the forest
Paola (not / see) a small animal in the forest
..... Paola(see) a big animal?



Yesterday, Jack (run) in the race with his friends
Yesterday, Jack (not / run) in the park
..... Jack (run) in the race?



Last day, she (read) a newspaper
Last day, she (not / read) a book
..... she (read) a newspaper?
