

A2 Key: Listening

You will need to be able to **listen and understand** people who are **talking together** or people who are **giving information** about something.

You will have to **choose** or **write answers** to questions which are about what these people say.

PART 1

You have to **identify key information** in five short dialogues and choose the correct **picture**.

- You'll hear something about all three pictures, but there's only one right answer. Make sure you **read the question very carefully**!
- **Listen carefully.** Don't only choose an answer because you hear something that you can see in one of the pictures.
- You will listen the recording **two times**:
 1. During the first listening, try to **listen for specific information** and **choose the best option**.
 2. Use the second listening to **check** if your answer is correct.



IMPORTANT: Listen **until the end** of each dialogue before you choose an answer.

You will hear five short conversations.

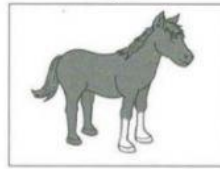
You will hear each conversation twice.

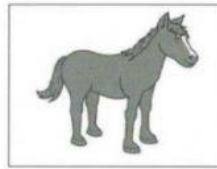
Which is the girl's horse?

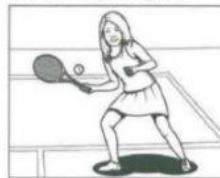
